
A Note from Code Compliance

Ordinance § 12.5-302 Blowing grass clippings into the road is a Code Violation. It's very easy to cut your grass in a way that doesn't blow the clippings into the road. You can cut the grass so that the discharge chute is aimed back at the yard. And if you don't want the clippings in your yard, simply rake them up. You won't be able to keep every single blade of grass in your yard, but that's understandable.

Cowboy Cookies

1 cup shortening (recommended Crisco)

1 cup granulated sugar

1 cup brown sugar

2 eggs

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon baking powder

2 cups rolled oats

1/2 cup chopped pecans

1 (6-ounce) package chocolate chips



- Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
- In a large mixing bowl with an electric mixer, cream the shortening, granulated sugar, and brown sugar.
- · Add eggs and the vanilla and beat until well blended.
- · Stir in the flour, baking soda, salt and baking powder.
- · Add oats, nuts, chocolate chips and coconut, mix until combined.
- Spoon cookie mixture onto greased foil lined cookie sheet.
- Bake for 8-10 minutes.
- Transfer the cookies to a wire rack to cool.

A RESIDENTS GUIDE TO

Property Maintenance



GRASS

Grass must be mowed, edged and free of weeds.



CLEAN YARD

Yards should be well-kept, clean and free of loose trash and debris.





TRIMMED TREES AND BUSHES

All trees must be trimmed at least 7ft above any sidewalk and 13.5 ft above the street, bushes should be neatly trimmed.



Junk and inoperable vehicles are not permitted. All vehicles must be parked on an improved surface. No vehicles are allowed to be parked on the grass or side yard.





FENCES

All fences must be well maintained, no missing or broken slats or panels.



OUTSIDE STORAGE

Shall not be located in the front yard and must be screened from public view Furniture, appliances, and trash may not be stored outside.



PAINT AND SIDING

Paint must be well maintained without chipping and siding must be intact.





TRASH

Trash cans may not be set out at the curb before 6pm the day before collection, and must be removed by 7am the day after collection. Bins must be stored out of view of the street per City Ordinance.
